On Tuesday, October 16, 2018, Mowlana Hazar Imam will attend a special, private ceremony for the inauguration of the Aga Khan Garden, Alberta, to be presided over by the Honorable Rachel Notley, Premier of Alberta. The Aga Khan Garden is located at the University of Alberta Botanic Garden at Devon, Alberta. This facility is about 45 minutes from downtown Edmonton.

Mowlana Hazar Imam will also be awarded an honorary degree by the University of Calgary in Calgary on Wednesday, October 17, 2018. He will be awarded honorary degrees by the University of British Columbia and Simon Fraser University in joint ceremony in Vancouver on Friday, October 19, 2018. He is being recognized for the voluminous work that he has done over the past 61 years to improve the quality of life of peoples around the world through the Aga Khan Development Network as well as remarkable achievements in many fields such as health, education, finance, civil society, Islamic architecture, environment, agriculture and forestry. The second niyat of this project is to recite 37 Venti Verses from Anant Akhado, gratitude dhikr and angelic salwat over a period of 7 days. This project is being executed at Belle Rive Jamat Khana, Edmonton, Alberta, Canada starting on **Friday, October 5, 2018** at **10** minutes before the first Dua.
